Withdrawal from the Mutual Threat Zone Agreement referred to previous Resolution 2019-05 as the out of area agreement

Resolution 2021-03

The Delta Fire Protection District encompasses Highway 12 from the Sacramento County line (halfway across the Rio Vista Bridge) to Jackson Slough Road/Hwy 12. The original Delta Fire Protection District boundaries were drawn prior to Highway 12 being constructed the LAFCO meeting on May 4th, 2021 corrected any confusion on emergency response. LAFCO's action redrew the district boundary. The Delta District is now responsible for Hwy 12 from the Sacramento County Line to Jackson Slough Road.

The purpose of this Resolution is to withdraw from Mutual Threat Zone agreement between the Rio Vista Fire Department (under contract to Delta Fire Protection District) and the River Delta Fire Protection District (formerly known as Isleton Fire Protection District). This Resolution will end any joint response and clarify the boundaries (as provided by LAFCO). Rio Vista Fire Department will confirm the response agreement between the two agencies and inform local Fire Dispatch centers (Solano and Sacramento).

The Delta District is now responsible for Hwy 12 from the Sacramento River to Jackson Slough Road. As such the Rio Vista Fire Department will provide fire and rescue services within this response area.

Rio Vista Fire Department will respond to any and all incidents within the Delta District including the Highway 12 corridor (Rio Vista Bridge to Jackson Slough Rd) and will assume Incident Command of incidents in the Delta Districts' jurisdiction. The River Delta Fire District shall not respond into the Delta District response area without a formal request for mutual aid through the Solano County Dispatch Center. Rio Vista will not respond east of Jackson Slough Road on Hwy 12 without a mutual aid request. This agreement will be in accordance with the California Master Mutual Aid Agreement set forth in Section 8561 of the California Government Code.

This resolution will effectively end the agreement once known as the Out of Area Service Agreement..
