- 4.2 Administrator's Report-
 - A. Payment of bills: \$25,642.60 M Wolfson, S Evert
 - B. General Financial Discussion: General Discussion of next year's budget was held and indications were that it would be a real tight budget, but after paying off the election costs from the county, and a debt, the following year will allow the district to begin enhancements and upgrades to the station building and grounds.
 - C. Giles Contract: Contract extended indefinitely. M Wolfson, S Evert
 - D. Revenues-Training Timing/Charges: Motion was made to move item 6.1 up to include it in this item. M Wolfson, S Evert
 - a) Chief Cutino discussed the need to increase the roster too 40 people while they are currently at approximately 26 with as many as 4 expected to obtain jobs and leave shortly. He felt that the training center should be scaled back until the staff is up to 40 and that they should concentrate on simple training. Staff generally stay about 3 years before finding permanent positions. Staff morale is down due to there being too many changes at once.
 - b) There are needs that are currently unmet including the NFRS system for Fire/EMS Records Management at \$,3859, and Battalion Chief Turn out suits two (2) at a cost of \$3,600 each. It was also concluded that C. McPeak should be hired at a cost of \$4,000 per month and Chief Cutino would give up his \$1,00 stipend per month to enable a more permanent staffing. starting in the month of June. M Wolfson, S Deak.
- 4.3 Telephone Charges: Discussion was held and it was decided that Director Wolfson and Chief Cutino would research a less costly and more reliable system.

- 5.1 By-Laws Revision: Discussion was held to accept the revisions M Evert S Wolfson
- 5.2 Screens, Air Conditioning Unit: Discussion was held that since the addition of the vineyard across the street that flies are much heavier requiring better screens on the windows and doors. They will be replaced or added at an approximate \$500 cost. M Wolfson S Evert, It was also decided that

there really need to be wall units of air conditioning in the two offices so people can work in them in the afternoon. Director Wolfson volunteered to obtain and install them cost unknown at this time. M Evert, S Deak
